PRIVACY POLICY

01. PURPOSE

We have implemented appropriate security measures to protect personal data against loss, unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration and destruction.

06. ACCESS TO AND CORRECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

We allow individuals to access their personal data and correct it if it is inaccurate. Access and correction requests will be processed in accordance with applicable legislation.

07. DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL DATA TO THIRD PARTIES

Personal data will only be disclosed to third parties in compliance with applicable legislation and with the consent of the individual concerned, unless disclosure is required by law.

08. RESPONSIBILITY AND COMPLIANCE

BC2 Groupe Conseil inc. has designated an individual to oversee compliance with this Policy and applicable legislation: Olivier Perron-Collins, President of BC2, has been appointed Privacy Officer.
